### **Iowa Catholic Conference Report:**

● **1) Pro-life** The Gallup Poll announced that for the 3rd straight year, more Americans call themselves "pro-life" than "pro-choice", this time 47 to 45 percent. Our legislative agenda on abortion remains steady. We continue to make the case that our society should protect those who can not protect themselves, whether in the womb or otherwise.

\* **2) Juveniles and Life Sentences** - The US Supreme Court ruled on May 17 that juveniles who commit crimes in which no one was killed may not be sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole. This will affect 7 prisoners in Iowa. ICC supports legislation in Iowa to eliminate the life sentence without the possibility of parole for minors.
